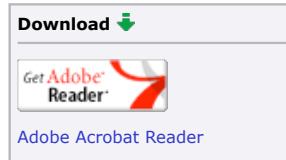

1.1 Before completing a CCCU application form you should read the information in this site. Make sure you have understood the university fee payment and refund procedures. Please read these at:

Only sign the acceptance of offer form, when you have done this. If you have any doubts or uncertainties clarify them by contacting the [International Office](#).

1.2 When applying for award bearing programmes (UG / PG / Foundation) you need to include copies of your academic certificates and English language exam results. If you want to apply for a Year 2 or 3 entry to an undergraduate programme, make sure you also include copies of transcripts and grades sheets of what you have already studied. You should supply a translation (you can do this yourself) of this. Information on the courses you have studied to accompany these is also very useful. Do not send originals. Attach these to the completed application form. You also need to send a reference letter for any Postgraduate programme - you can send this with the application form, or you can send it later if it is difficult to obtain quickly. Please note that if you are an EU national you must pay the Equivalent Learning Qualification fee for your studies if you have already undertaken three years of undergraduate study.

1.3 If you are under 18, the application form must also be signed by your parent or guardian. You also need to send us a completed Under 18s Consent Form. Make sure that you obtain this from the International Office if you need it.

1.4 If you are an International student (from any country other than Great Britain and Northern Ireland), the address to send all application forms for all programmes is:
